The Valedictorian and Salutatorian will be chosen based on the following criteria:

- 1. All candidates must have a cumulative GPA of 4.0 at the end of the third quarter of their Senior year.
- 2. Class rank will be determined using a point system valuing classes from the areas of English, Math, Science, and Social Science.
